

Foundation

- In 2008 the Global Forest Fund initiated as FEEs internal compensation tool.
- More than € 80,000 has been invested into over 120 projects.
- Since 2017 with support from the Mars Wrigley Foundation FEE has developed a new concept for the GFF.



Objectives of the Global Forest Fund

- To educate young people and their communities around the world and equip them with the tools to be more environmentally conscious
- To reinforce this learning through hands-on tree-planting to capture carbon
- To provide direct actions to combat climate change and increase biodiversity
- To continue to reduce environmental impacts long after the trees are planted
