



# Field trip to Mata dos Medos (Pine Dune Forest)

Agrupamento de Escolas Carlos Gargaté/Charneca de Caparica – Portugal



Mata dos Medos is a Pine Dune Forest, in the Área Protegida da Arriba Fóssil da Costa da Caparica (Protected Area of the Costa de Caparica Fossil Cliffs) with an área of 1.551,55 ha; it is a mediterranean forest type that the king D. João V order that it would be sown, almost continuously along the coastal dunes. This vegetation type develops in sheltered areas behind the littoral zone, where with some protection from the salt wind it may develop with pines (*Pinus pinea*).

The PPAFCC symbol corresponds to a scallop (shell), a common name given to the genus Pecten of the Lamellibranchiata class (class of molluscs that include all those that have bivalve shells, such as clams, oysters, mussels, etc.) common name Concha Vieira.

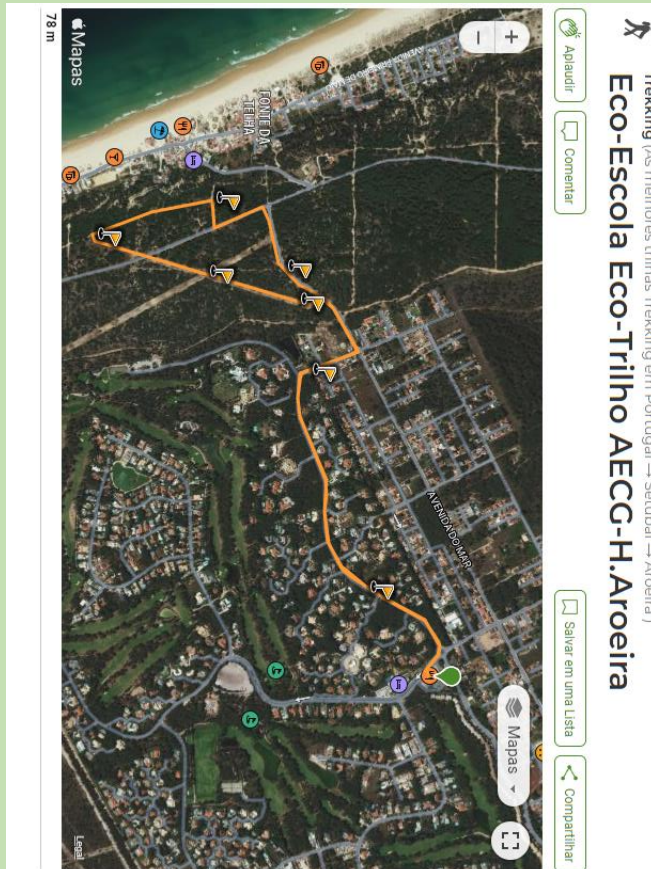

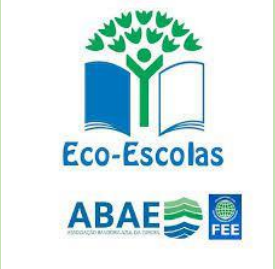
